1. Introduction

As part of the BRECSA project, a series of comprehensive training programs on climate SMART agriculture production, livestock practices, and mushroom cultivation were conducted from 04 to 13 August 2025 across four target districts. The trainings were organized in collaboration with local gewog administrations and facilitated by Tarayana Foundation field officers, BRECSA project staff, and technical resource persons.

The training locations included:

- Chhudzom Gewog (Sarpang)
- Bjoka Gewog (Zhemgang)
- Tsirangtoe Gewog (Tsirang)
- Drakteng Gewog (Trongsa)

The design of these training modules was informed by district-level training needs assessments and community consultations. They aimed to strengthen farmers' resilience, improve food security and nutrition, and promote climate-smart, sustainable farming practices.

2. Objectives

The training programs had the following core objectives:

- Build farmers' technical capacity in climate SMART agricultural practices to improve productivity while minimizing environmental impact.
- Promote organic farming and natural input use (bio-pesticides, compost, liquid fertilizers) to reduce reliance on chemical inputs
- Enhance livelihood and income opportunities, with a special focus on women, youth and people living with disabilities (PWD).
- Improve household food security and nutrition through diversified cropping systems and sustainable resource use.

- Strengthen climate resilience by teaching adaptation strategies, sustainable land management, and livestock waste recycling.
- Support livestock management practices that integrate waste utilization and soil fertility improvement.

3. Methodology

The training employed a participatory and hands-on approach, ensuring that farmers could directly practice the techniques. Key methods included:

- Field demonstrations on composting, hydroponics, mushroom cultivation, and orchard management.
- Practical exercises in preparing natural pesticides, liquid manure, and mushroom substrates.
- Group work and interactive discussions to foster peer-to-peer learning.
- Use of locally available materials for affordable and replicable solutions.
- Integration of traditional practices with modern techniques to ensure cultural relevance.
- Provision of follow-up support mechanisms to guide implementation after the training.

4. Facilitators and Participants

The training team comprised:

- Resource persons: Passang Tobgay and other technical experts.
- Field officers: Namgay, Jigme Wangchuk, and district-based Sanam Jabchorpas (SJs).
- BRECSA project staff for coordination and technical backstopping.

4.1 Participation:

- A total of 63 participants in Chhudzom Gewog (29 female, 34 male).

- Additional participants in Bjoka, Tsirangtoe, and Drakteng Gewogs.
- Balanced representation of men, women, and youth, including smallholder farmers and semi-commercial producers.

5. District-Specific Training Content

5.1 Sarpang

- Vermicomposting and heap composting
- Seed preservation and community seed banking
- Low-cost organic manure preparation

5.2 Tsirang

- Vermicomposting for soil enrichment
- Hydroponic management (soilless farming techniques for vegetables)

5.3 Trongsa

- Sustainable land management to reduce erosion
- Composting and orchard management (pruning, spacing, care)
- Polyhouse management for extended cropping seasons

5.4 Zhemgang

- Heap composting with local residues
- Polyhouse management for improved crop quality
- Biochar production and use as a soil enhancer

5.5 Cross-cutting Livestock Training (all districts)

- Cow waste management and liquid manure preparation

5.6 Organic pesticides from locally available ingredients

- Circular use of livestock waste for soil fertility

5.7 Special Commodities (Mushroom Cultivation)

- Training on oyster and paddy straw mushrooms
- Substrate preparation, sterilization, spawning, incubation, and harvesting
- Plans to expand honey production in future training cycle

6. Key Results and Findings

- Farmers successfully learned mushroom production cycles, with many expressing readiness to adopt cultivation.
- Strong uptake of bio-fertilizer and natural pesticide preparation using garlic, ginger, chili, and cow urine.
- Farmers demonstrated ability to convert invasive species (e.g., Crofton weed) into compost.
- Introduction of biochar technology was well received as a soil fertility enhancer. Nutrition awareness sessions improved understanding of dietary diversity and household food security.
- Participant's feedback confirmed the training content was relevant, practical, and immediately applicable.

7. Impacts

- Individual level: Increased skills in sustainable crop and livestock practices; reduced reliance on chemical inputs.
- Household level: Better dietary diversity and food availability through nutrition-sensitive agriculture.
- Community level: Strengthened farmer networks, peer learning, and joint problem-solving.
- Economic impact: New income streams from mushroom farming, particularly benefiting women and youth.

- Environmental impact: Improved soil health, circular use of waste, and climate resilience.

8. Recommendations

- Provide starter kits (mushroom spawn, seeds, tools) for immediate adoption.
- Establish district-level resource hubs for continuous technical support.
- Conduct seasonal refresher training and systematic follow-up visits.
- Integrate NSA practices into school curricula and gewog development plans.
- Strengthen market linkages for mushrooms and organic produce.
- Introduce policy support: subsidies for organic inputs, organic certification, and infrastructure (cold storage).
- Encourage research partnerships for locally adapted varieties and yield optimization.
- Develop farmer-friendly materials in local languages and dialects.

9. Conclusion

The BRECSA training programs in August 2025 successfully built the capacity of farmers in four target districts on climate SMART agriculture, livestock practices, and mushroom cultivation. The participatory, hands-on design ensured that farmers not only gained technical knowledge but also practical skills applicable to their local contexts.

The trainings directly contributed to income generation, food and nutrition security, and climate resilience by aligning with BRECSA's broader goal of strengthening smallholder agriculture in Bhutan. Sustained follow-up, resource support, and institutional integration will be critical to scaling and sustaining these impacts.
